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This letter is in response to your field representative, Mr. Lee Plummer's request for our experience with Primrose #751 ATF fluid.

It is safe to say at the outset that transmission failures in our fleet of hard working fracing units has been an expensive and nagging problem for years.

After a meeting last year with your company representative in which he reviewed technical data and the success experienced by Schlumberger's Worland, Wy terminal it was our decision to run a "Field Trial" using Primrose Pure Synthetic Paó 12 chain ATF fluid in some of our frac units.

The results after months of in field operations parallel the Worland terminal conclusions. We have had no further maintenance problems involving transmission fluids.

This is a very busy terminal, however, we extended our "Field Trials" to include 750 Allison Transmission powering our cementers. In the past we have used Exxon Mobile and Shell Oil ATF fluids. The results of going to Primrose truly caught our attention as operators observed temperature reductions of as much as 48 to 50 degrees F.

We intend to continue using your fluids which have greatly reduced costs involved with expensive transmission repairs over the year.
